

## **Panjabi School Rules**

1. Admission will take place three times in a year – in the first two weeks of each term, in September, January and April. Children must be over 5 (five) years of age.
2. Curriculum consists of teaching Panjabi, Sikh Religious Education, Sikh History and Cultural awareness.
3. School Times: 9.45am to 1.00 pm. Please attend 15 minutes early.
4. Children must wear suitable clothes. Wearing of ear rings, jewellery and caps is not allowed. As part of the school uniform, boys must wear `Kesri` turbans and girls. `Kesri` chunis.
5. An Assembly is held where the children take-off their shoes, cover their heads and sit on the floor for prayers. They last for approx. 30 mins. but on special occasions Assemblies can be extended.
6. Sikh children are expected to observe tenets of the Sikh Faith; parents are requested to encourage them.
7. Children must participate in all school activities.
8. Pupils must attend regularly. A child who remains absent continuously for three weeks without prior notice, will be struck off the register.
9. The Trustees and the School Staff wish to maintain a high standard of discipline. Children are expected to do well in their education, behave well, respect their teachers and elders, look after school property and come equipped with their books and stationary.
10. Complaint/s of any nature must firstly be lodged with the Head Teacher or Deputy Head, who are responsible for running the school. There is a set procedure in following serious complaints, which the education committee will be able to deal.
