Re: Update on COVID-19

I am writing to provide you with an update on COVID-19 at KPS.

First of all, I would like to say a big thank you to all parents for their support in these unpredicted times. It's been a tough few weeks at Khalsa Primary School and we wouldn't have been able to manage this without your cooperation and understanding. As you will know, we are following Government guidelines in everything that we do.

Classrooms

It has been brought to my attention that a number of the children are feeling cold at School.

We are following [Government Guidelines](#) in that windows are open just enough to provide constant background ventilation and opened more fully during breaks to purge the air in the space.

Please be assured the heating has been on since the return of children in September 2020. Monday is our coldest day of the week as the heating is switched off over the weekend and takes time for the heating to circulate throughout the building.

Can I please ask parents to ensure their child is dressed appropriately for the winter period. If children are feeling cold they may wish to wear thermal clothing, but please ensure that children do not overheat.

Positive COVID-19 cases at KPS

As you may be aware we have had a number of positive cases at Khalsa Primary School. The minute we find out there has been a positive case, we speak to Public Health England for their advice and the steps we must follow – including any child or staff member that may need to isolate.

To provide you with an update, we've had five positive cases, 2 children and 3 staff members. I am pleased to say our children from Year 1 and Year 2 have returned this week. It was lovely to see their smiley faces again. On Monday 23rd November 2020, we had a positive case in a child which meant Year 4 had to isolate. They are due to return to school on Tuesday 1st December 2020.

Please be assured we are doing everything we can to keep our children and staff safe. We are following all Government and Public Health England guidelines.

Most of you will have seen me in the car park/playground during drop off and pick up time. Feel free to stop and talk to me if you have any queries. In addition, if there is anything more we can do please do not hesitate to contact me.
