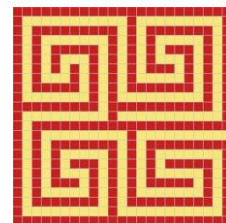
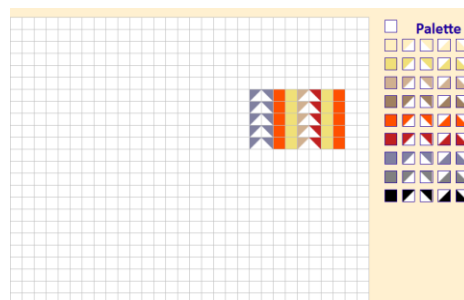
Roman Mosaic
