All pupils in KS2 were asked to create something imaginative to do with the 10th Guru. In the end there were 4 categories: 3D Art; 2D Art; Poetry; Facts.

The winning children were given specially engraved glass trophies as their prizes. Well done to the children that won either 1st, 2nd or 3rd prize in the competition.

Parent Mail

Parent Mail is Khalsa Primary School's main form of communication with parents. We are using less paper and moving to electronic communication.

The Office staff are having a 'clean up' of Parent Mail to ensure we have your correct email address and mobile number. If you do not receive any electronic communication from the School please speak to the office staff.

As of 13th December 2017 our Parent Mail statistics showed that:

99% of families receive SMS 98% of families receive emails 94% of families have a Parent Mail account 47% of families are using the Parent Mail mobile app.

We are urging all parents to use Parent Mail more often. Please download the Parent Mail app from your App Store (free) and login to your account.

Are vou entitled?


If you do not have an email address, then you can get a 'free school meals' application form from the School Office. The school will then inform you if your application is successful or not.

There are clear advantages in pupils having a school dinner, so the Government have announced that every child in the above year groups will be eligible for a free meal under the Universal Free School Meals scheme.



We note there has been a mix up with communication this term. From January 2018 we are looking to improve our communication. Please work with us whilst we make changes to our communication techniques.



Class DoJo

From January 2018 all staff will be using Class Dojo more to communicate with parents. You should expect to receive at least two Dojo messages a week.

Attendance

We recently issued a communication regarding our policy on lateness and holidays taken during term time.

Lates

We are urging all parents to get their children to School on time. As a trial we have increased our drop off time by a further 5 minutes from 8:20 to 8:35am. We have noticed a significant improvement since implementing this change - w/e 1st December 2017 there were 100 lates compared to w/e 8th December 2017 with only 48 lates.

Holidays during term time

Holidays during term time are not permitted. Please refrain from taking your child out of School during term time. The local authority will fine parents if they take their children out of School during term time - three parents have already been fined.

Attendance

Our overall attendance figures have dropped dramatically. As of 15th December 2017 our attendance was 96.34%. In 2016 the attendance figure was 98%. Anything below 96% is classed as inadequate. We are urging all parents to please refrain from taking your children out of School unless absolutely necessary.

Medical

All parents have recently been contacted regarding their child and any medical conditions they may have. If your child has medication in School or suffers from any allergies/asthma and you have not completed a medical form please contact the School Office as a matter of urgency.
