Experiment with new instruments to create music together.

WOW factor:

Visit to a local park to collect natural objects, create sculptures and observe seasonal changes

Critical Thinking

Read and discuss the book 'The Jolly Postman' by Janet & Allan Ahlberg.

Write simple sentences and write a letter to different characters.

Read and compare 'The months' by Sara Coleridge, 'Weather' by Meish Goldish and 'Dripsy Dropsy' by Leanne Guenther.

Write an acrostic poem.

Write instructions using imperative verbs and adverbs of time.

Observe changes in weather and describe seasons.

Evaluate their own and others' creations.

The World and Me

Understand the difference between rules and expectations.

Learn about healthy eating: Discuss positives and negatives of sugar. Discuss dental hygiene and obesity.

Understand that we have responsibilities.

Know how to keep safe and how and where to get help (PANTS, NSPCC).
