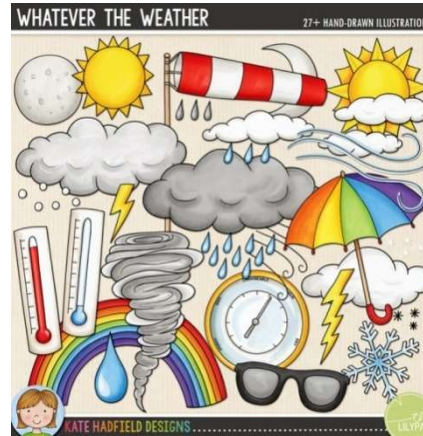
Year 1 – Autumn 1: Whatever the Weather

Collaboration

As collaborators we will work together to create a weather mobile. We will find out facts about the weather to share with others as a news report.

Creativity

As creators, we will think creatively in our learning and begin to learn new techniques for how to make and present our work.



The World and Me

As super citizens, we will consider the impact we have on our Earth and what we can do to make it a better place to live. We will visit our local environment.

Critical Thinking

As learners, we will use our higher order thinking skills such as comparing, contrasting and evaluation.

As Writers we will...

Say out loud what we are going to write about. We will say our sentences before we write them. We will start to sequence sentences to write short narratives.

As Readers we will...

Use our phonics to decode, listen to and discuss a wide range of texts. We will begin to link what we read or hear to our own experiences and perform stories to

As Mathematicians we will...

Count, read, write, identify, represent, double and half, use number bonds and use comparative language. Recognise common 2-D and 3-D shapes, describe position, direction and movement.

As sportsperson we will...

perform dances using simple movement patterns.

As Geographers we will...

Identify seasonal and daily weather patterns in the UK and the location of hot and cold areas of the world in relation to the Equator and the North and South Poles.

As Historians we will...

Discuss important historical events, people and places in Slough. We will research events from before we were born that are important nationally or globally.

As Scientists we will...

Observe changes across the 4 seasons and describe weather associated with the seasons, including how day length varies. We will begin to suggest answers to questions.

As Entrepreneurs we will...

Raise money for charitable causes. Create and design products related to our learning.

As Musicians we will...

Listen with concentration to a range of music and play unturned instruments. We will creatively explore the use of expression in our voices by singing songs, and speaking chants and rhymes.

As Digital Citizens we will...

Recognise common uses of IT beyond school. We will use technology safely and respectfully, keeping personal information private. We will learn where to go for help when they have concerns about what we see online.

As Artists and Designers we will...

Use a range of materials creatively to design and make products. We look at the work of a specific sculpture artist who focuses on colour, pattern and form.

As Faith learners we will...

Retell a range of religious stories and explain how they link to the core beliefs and practices. We will Learn and recap First 3 sets of letter sounds in Panjabi (First 15 alphabets and mu). How to tell the weather in Panjabi (sunny, cold, cloudy, frosty)
