As Writers we will...

We will sequence stories with familiar settings to write a short story and a diary entry about pirates using playful and inventive language.

As Readers we will...

Listen to, sequence and retell stories about the sea. We will look at language choices in poetry and the effects of the layout, rhythm & rhyme.

As Mathematicians we will...

Use place value and number facts to solve problems. We will understand that addition is commutative and use concrete objects to solve problems.

As sportspeople we will...

master basic movements including running, jumping, throwing and catching, as well as developing balance, agility and co-ordination, and begin to apply these in a range of activities. Also we will perform dances using simple movement patterns.

As Geographers we will...

Identify and name the world's continents and oceans and understand the purpose of maps. We will also name and identify key physical features such as: coast, forest, vegetation.

As Historians we will...

Discuss important historical events, people and places in Slough. We will research and celebrate events that are important nationally or globally.

As Scientists we will...

Explore and observe how things are moving and make comparisons such as faster and slower. We will understand that sounds get fainter as the distance increases.

As faith learners we will....

will describe some festivals, celebrations and practices and say how they reflect the core beliefs. As Panjabi speakers, we will Recap first 4 sets of letter sounds and 3 vowels (First 15 alphabets and kanna, bihari and sihari vowels). Learn next 1 set of letter sounds (Next 5 alphabets. Start making mukta words

As Musicians we will...

Select and order sounds. We will represent sounds with symbols and recognise how sounds can be organised.

As Digital Citizens we will...

Give instructions, plan, discuss and review work developed using ICT safely. We will understand the importance of passwords and logging in safely. We will understand the difference between real and imaginary.

Experiment with line, shape, pattern and colour. We will identify a purpose for what we plan to make and discuss improvements.
