Revisit place value – including rounding and working with large numbers, as well as working on decimals and their value.

Apply these methods to solve a variety of real life problems and develop our reasoning skills.

Develop our understanding of electrical components, constructing circuits with an increasing number of components, analysing the effects this has on the function of components.

Research how electricity is generated both traditionally and today, focussing on how electricity is generated in Slough.

Create a media— rich blog, comment on logs and respond to comments and use hyperlinks within our blog, linking it to appropriate content elsewhere on the web.

Use the animated film 'Wall-E' and write an effective description using the senses. To choose the appropriate register for diary entries from different points of view.

Create a movement patterns to the story and music form the Sorcerer's apprentice and evaluate our composition thinking about the effectiveness of the movement.

Create volcanic art work inspired by the work of artist Margret Godfrey
