Collaboration

As collaborators we will take turns and consider different views. We will respond to each other's opinions.

Creativity

As creators, we will think creatively in our learning and begin to learn new techniques for how to make and present our work.

As super citizens, we will help others and understand that there are people less fortunate than us; we will share.

Critical Thinking

As learners, we will use our higher order thinking skills such as comparing, investigating, ordering and evaluating.

As Writers we will...enjoy and share a range of stories and films based in different fantasy worlds. We will also use a simple structure to organise and base a story in a fantasy neighbourhood.

As Readers we will...make predictions when reading longer stories and discuss the ways the author makes the reader interested. We will list the fantastical aspects of the stories and films shared.

As Mathematicians we will... recognise and use symbols for pound and pence and combine amounts in different ways. Identify and describe the properties of 3D shapes and look at symmetry.

As sportspeople we will... master basic movements including running, jumping, throwing and catching, as well as developing balance, agility and co-ordination, and begin to apply these in a range of activities.

As Geographers we will... Ask and respond to questions about people, places and environment. We will recognise, observe, describe and record physical and human features.

As Historians we will...research the local area's history. We will look at pictures and drawings to identify the changes over the years.

As Scientists we will... Identify and compare the suitability of everyday materials. We will also find out how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching.

As faith learners we will... As Panjabi speakers, we will recap first 4 sets of letter sounds and 5 vowels (First 15 alphabets and kanna, Bihari, Sihari, Lawan Dolawan vowels). Reading and writing simple words. We will learn about shops and restaurants.

As Musicians we will...represents sounds with symbols, play musical instruments with expression and control. We will also recognise and explore how sounds can be organised.

As Digital Citizens we will...use digital cameras and tablets to take photos of the local area. These will be used to create an information booklet using Microsoft Publisher.

As Artists and Designers we will...be looking at the drawings of L.S. Lowry. we will create our own Lowry style drawing of the local area. We will experiment with the visual elements of line, shape, pattern and colour.
