We will learn about a culture that is different from our own one and learn about the history of that culture.

We will think about which sources of evidence have survived from this era and how they were discovered? What do they tell us?

As Historians we will...

Carry out an in depth study of Ancient Egypt. We will look at how it has changed over the years and its contribution to the modern world.

As Digital Citizens we will...

As Musicians we will...

Perform, listen to, review and evaluate music across a range of genres, styles and traditions. Develop an understanding of the history of music. Play and perform in solo ensemble contexts.

As faith learners, we will...

Examine the history of Vaisakhi and understand the discipline of Sikhs. As Panjabi speakers, we will recap all 9 vowel sounds and all 7 sets of letter sounds. Reading and writing sentences with connectives and powerful vocabulary. Learning about present and past tenses.

As PSHE learners we will...

Strengthen our own sense of identity while raising awareness of the influences around us. We will explore how choices are made, what influences those choices and how to take greater responsibility for our own safety.

As Writers we will...

Write stories to scare. Use features identified in other stories, written to entertain.

As Scientists we will...

Investigate and develop an understanding of different types of materials. We will plan and carry out experiments to see how materials go through reversible and irreversible changes. We will deepen our understanding of different types of variables.

As sportspeople, we will ... As sportspeople, we will use running, jumping, throwing and catching in isolation and in combination. We will also compare our performances with previous ones and demonstrate improvement to achieve our personal best.

As Mathematicians we will...

Learn about Fractions, Decimals and percentages. We will practise how to convert from one form to another. We will solve problems using this knowledge.

As Artists and Designers we will...

Use sketchbooks to record our observations and use them to review and revisit ideas. We will improve our mastery in stitching. We look at the work of a specific artist and focus on colour, line and pattern.

As Readers we will...

Read and identify features of scary stories. We will pick out the features of a scary story to entertain the reader.

As Geographers, we will... Compare the geographical features of Egypt to the UK. Look at the location and significance of the River Nile in Egypt.
