As collaborators we will work together to discuss and share ideas to design our product. We will also make our product as a team and work together to improvise.

Creativity

Critical Thinking

As learners, we will discuss how people's life influenced by the environment they live.

As a performer we will...

use drama to persuade others to try our products. The children will also use conscious alley technique to discuss and debate dilemmas the character face in the story.

As Digital Citizens we will...

learn that programs execute by following clear instructions. Know that programs respond to inputs to do different things. Learn to write a simple code.

As Musicians we will...

play and perform in solo and ensemble contexts, using our voices and playing musical instruments. Learn to improvise and compose music for a range of purposes.

As a super citizen (through PSHE) we will...

Understand and appreciate the range of different cultures and religions represented within school/ community. Learn about the need for tolerance for those of different faiths and belief.

As a Panjabi learner we will...

Learnt to write numbers in Panjabi. Apply all the sounds learnt in Year 3 to read words and simple sentences. Use our phonics skills in Panjabi lessons to segment and blend sounds correctly.

As Writers we will...

learn to write stories. The focus will be on character and setting descriptions. Children will be using a range of engaging vocabulary to interest the readers.

As Scientists we will...

learn about animals including humans. We will identify that humans and some other animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement. We will carry out various experiments to find out how our body works.

As sportspeople we will...

take part in outdoor and adventurous activity challenges both individually and within a team. Pupils will learn to apply basic principles suitable for attacking and defending.

As Mathematicians we will...

Solve problems involving the four operations. We will use number facts to solve mathematical problems. Use the correct and the best method when answering a question.

As Artists and Designers we will...

understand and apply the principles of a healthy and varied diet. Prepare simple dishes and describe the techniques used to create the dish. Learn to use a range of cooking techniques.

As a Geographer we will...

Learn about Dover, France and Canada. Identify the position of all three places in the world, along with climate, capital city, time zone, population and area. Learn about the human and physical geography of each place, drawing comparisons.

As Readers we will...

discuss words and phrases that capture the reader's interest and imagination. Children will learn to identify main ideas and summarising from more than 1 paragraph.
